Advisors were saying that nobody would attend and that there is no way the air would clear by Saturday... but God!


Times Square 2023

approximately 20,000 people stream through Times Square. Our six-hour event would impact in various degrees tens of thousands! Over the past six months, we have ministered to well over 6000 students and families through assemblies, festivals, leadership development trainings, literacy initiatives, kids' clubs and Easter Egg Hunts!

Our "**Read to Succeed**" literacy initiative has transformed the lives of hundreds of children. One first grader grew 7 reading levels (from below K, to above 2nd grade) through 12 one-hour sessions. His life will never be the same.

Our "**Hope Kidz Club**" blessed dozens of children in four different elementary schools. Joy, love, music, games and good news enriched each child who attended this wonderful after school program.

A beautiful relationship has been growing between **Urban Hope and the schools of Staten Island**. After many years of serving and co-laboring with local principals and teachers, a door has opened wide to come alongside our beloved NYC DOE students. Hundreds of thousands are struggling to overcome family challenges, neighborhood violence and the pandemic educational loss that particularly devastated areas of deep poverty.

We are asking for unprecedented prayer and support at this juncture. This is by far our most ambitious new initiative, to create a church facilitated "**continuum of care**" for students that provides strategic intervention from K-12th grade. There is a long shadowy valley that our children need to navigate. Please pray that we can be instrumental in bringing them to green pastures and into the house of the Lord forever.

During the assemblies we mobilize teams of students who want to make a positive difference in their school and community. These students are then




provided with world-class, values based, leadership training!
